SAAPAM maintains the highest ethical and academic standards. A selection panel appointed by the National Board of SAAPAM will review all abstracts and author(s) will be notified within 2 weeks after deadline for submission. Both national and international referees from the field and discipline of Public Administration and Management will be appointed to the selection panel. The papers will be made available through a published conference proceeding in the accredited Journal of Public Administration. To this end, authors will have to submit the **final copies of their papers in appropriate article format** for adjudication to the Conference Coordinator no later than **28 August 2009**.

The Theme for the 10th Annual Conference is: The changing face of leadership and governance: Adapt, influence, sustain. This theme was selected as South Africa and most other states are facing global economic, social and political challenges. New leadership styles and renewed political commitment are required to sustain societal wellbeing.

The sub-themes are:

- Sub-theme 1: Creating and sustaining an enabling policy framework for the changing face of leadership and governance
- Sub-theme 2: Leading the changing face of governance through sustainable human resource management
- Sub-theme 3: Responsible financial management in the changing face of governance
- Sub-theme 4: Governing good, governing well: The ethical face of leadership and governance
- Sub-theme 5: Adapting, influencing and sustaining local government
- Sub-theme 6: Monitoring and evaluation in the changing face of governance
